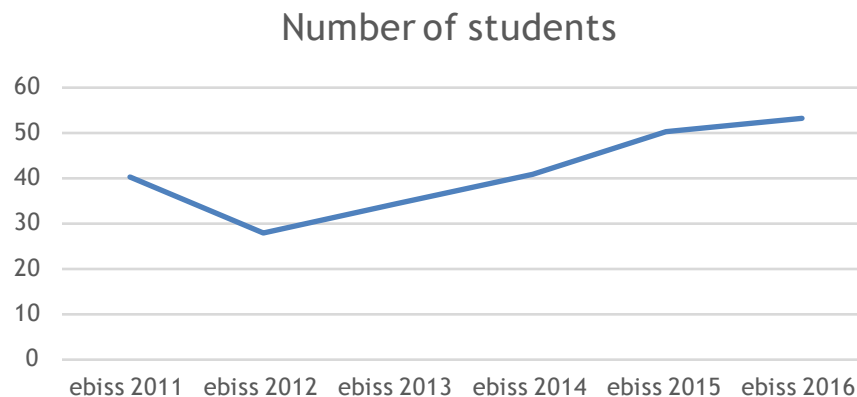

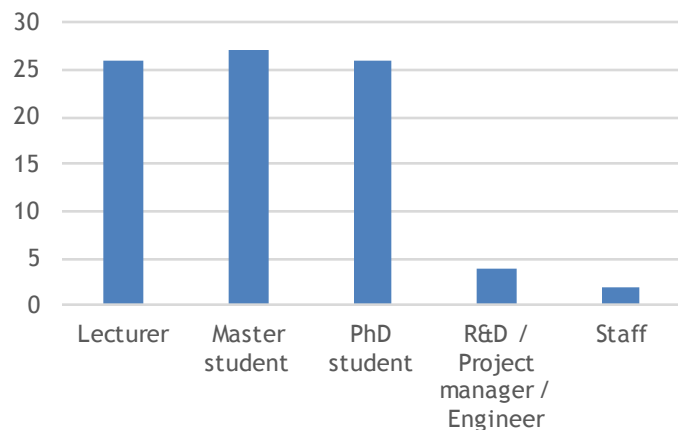
Facts

 - 3 grants covering registration and accommodation

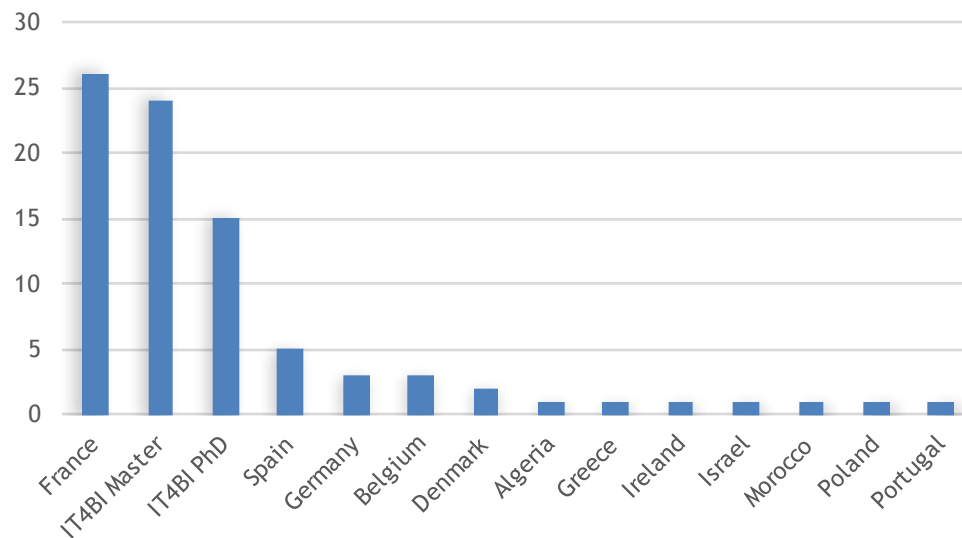

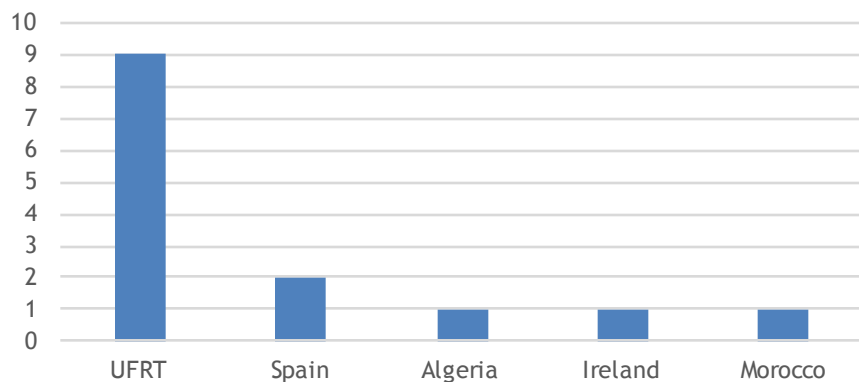
Participants by position
